13TH ENOHE CONFERENCE
STRASBOURG, 28-30 JUNE 2017

ACCESS TO STRASBOURG

Strasbourg (<http://www.otstrasbourg.fr/en/>), the host city of ENOHE's 13th annual conference, is the capital of the French region of Alsace, close to the border with Germany. **It is accessible by air, rail or car.**

Some **international flights** serve Strasbourg's Entzheim airport (<http://strasbourg.aeroport.fr/en>). Other flights to Strasbourg are routed via Paris, Brussels, Prague and a limited number of other European cities. Frankfurt/Main airport is also a convenient air connection to access Strasbourg, in which case you may continue by train or shuttle to Strasbourg.

Strasbourg can also easily be accessed by **train**, since there are efficient direct train connections from several major European cities (<https://uk.voyages-sncf.com/en/train/france/eastern-france/strasbourg#/>).

- **FROM ENTZHEIM AIRPORT TO STRASBOURG**

There are 4 TER trains per hour from Entzheim Airport to Strasbourg Station and back. The journey takes about 9 minutes. Price of the Tram+TER ticket: **4.30 €**. With this ticket you can combine Tram-Bus-Train, it is valid for one hour and a half.

- **FROM FRANKFURT AIRPORT TO STRASBOURG**

If arriving in Frankfurt/Main (<https://www.frankfurt-airport.com/en/f>) a Lufthansa shuttle bus is available at **Terminal 1: THE SQUAIRE WEST, next to the mainline station (exit by REWE)**. It takes 2h30-3h to travel to Strasbourg. 2 stops are on the way: Railway station and Hilton Hotel. - **FROM STRASBOURG MAIN RAILWAY STATION TO THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT**

Once arrived in Strasbourg main station, a single ticket from the main station costs **1.70€** and should be bought from the machine on the platform. Take **tram C** from the Railway Station (platform is on ground level to the left-hand side of the station when leaving) and get off at **Republique**. With the same ticket, take **Tram E** direction **Robertsau** and get off at **Parlement Européen** (cf map).

TAXIS: In Strasbourg you can find taxis at the **Railway Station** and near the **Homme de Fer tram stop**. A taxi from/to town will cost approximately **10 €**.

VISAS FOR FRANCE (IF NECESSARY)

In order to obtain a **visa** valid for France and the Schengen area (if necessary; see <http://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/coming-to-france/getting-a-visa/>), timely requests should be made at your respective French diplomatic or Consular Office at least once week before the date of departure.

ACCESS TO THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT

Your **passport number** will be needed in advance (via the conference registration form) for issuing the conference badges. Conference participants are requested to bring an **identity document** and to present it at the entrance of the Building of the European Parliament each morning.

CONFERENCE FEES

- **1 : For ENOHE Members**

The conference fee for ENOHE members is **€ 320,-**. This includes the conference badges and conference materials, access to the conference venue, the European Parliament (guided tour included), refreshments and meals during the conference and the conference dinner in the evening of 29th June.

(Note: Due to the relocation of the ENOHE Secretariat from England to Norway no annual membership fees for 2017 have been collected to date. It is advisable to pay the annual membership fee of **€ 50,-** and the then reduced conference fee of **€ 320,-** in a single transfer, total amount **€ 370,-** when registering for the conference.)

- **2 : For non-members**

The conference fee for non-members is **€ 400,-**. If you want to become an ENOHE member and take advantage of the reduced conference fee for the 2017 conference, proceed as mentioned under 1.

- **ENOHE Dinner on Thursday 29th June 2017**

The traditional ENOHE dinner, this year in the evening of Thursday, 29th June 2017, is included in the conference fee (members and non-members). For guests (partners, spouses, friends) there will be an extra charge of **€ 65,- per person**. You should include the respective amount in your total sum when registering. You will then be invoiced accordingly.
